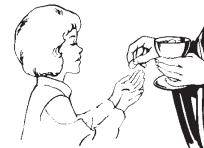

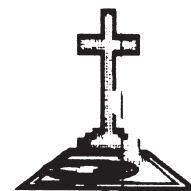

St Charles, the diocese's college preparatory school for boys, is located at 2010 E Broad Street.



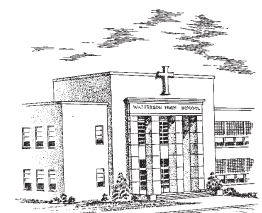
