Even if they date it 2007, it cannot be accepted. The general rule is that it must either be in the Church Office by December 31 or it must be postmarked December 31 or before. It is our understanding that there is no "grace period" with the IRS!!

To allow everybody to plan ahead, I take note of important **liturgies for the Christmas season**. The **parish Penance Service** will be on **Wednesday, December 19th, at 7:00 p.m.** Several visiting priests will be available to help everybody celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Christmas. **Masses for Christmas will be on Christmas Eve at 5:00 p.m., 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. and on Christmas Day at 9:00 a.m.** There will be **no confessions on Saturday, December 29th**. I will be catching an early morning flight from O’Hare that day and should be back by noon, but I might be a bit late. Masses for **January 1st, a Holy Day of Obligation**, will be on **December 31st, at 6:00 p.m. and on January 1st at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.** The bulletin will continue to note these times during Advent.

Last week’s collection was \$17,843.00.

**St. Vincent de Paul Winter Coat Drive**

The St. Timothy’s St. Vincent de Paul Conference is sponsoring its annual “Coats-for-Christmas” campaign. It continues every weekend before Christmas. Parishioners are encouraged to donate to this cause during the weekends following Thanksgiving when members will accept donations at the church doors after weekend Masses. Suggested contribution is \$20.00 or whatever is affordable.
