From the Pastor’s Desk

The Finance Committee meeting on Tuesday evening brought some good news and some bad news. To date, parishioners have contributed nearly \$600,000.00 to the Capital Campaign and our debt is now below \$1 million. Thank you, thank you, thank you! The staff has managed to keep expenditures down. Except for salaries and benefits (over which, we exercise only slight control), we are doing as well as last year. The new heating and air conditioning system in the lower level of the school is up and running. We’re still trying to adjust the temperature properly, but we’re no longer at the mercy of the aging boiler and our fuel bills should decline, too. The bad news is that our collection income is down around \$40,000.00 from last year. The committee didn’t know whether this was an effect of the economic downturn or people’s generosity to the Capital Campaign or something else. It is no cause for panic, but it certainly calls for watchfulness. Again, I must say, “Thank you,” to everyone for being so generous and I can assure you of the committee’s eagerness to be frugal in planning next year’s budget.
