Fourth Month Baby Update

The baby's brain has begun maturing in a process that will continue until it is about 14 years old. Its eyelids are now sealed shut and will reopen at 7 months. Its taste buds are working. Nutrients consumed by the mother are passed on to it within an hour or two. Three hundred quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on the head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month, REM (rapid eye movements) have been recorded (a sign of dreaming).

The Respect Life Committee is having Masses offered for the intentions of our spiritually adopted babies in danger of abortion on the following dates: July 1, August 5, September 2, October 7, November 4, and December 2. On these dates, please unite in prayer with all those who are praying for a baby in danger of abortion.
