A Word from Your Pastor

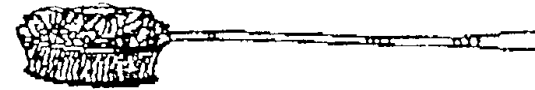
Dear Parishioners:

As this bulletin goes to press, I am with many of my brother priests on retreat at the St. Therese Retreat Center. To prepare for this time away for my annual retreat, I arranged for the daily Masses to be celebrated by four different priests. It was not easy to find priests free to celebrate these Masses. I am grateful to my brothers in the priesthood for their willingness to assist us.

St. Timothy has had the luxury of more than one priest through most of its years as a parish. Now you have one, yours truly. This means that some of the expectations we have all had will need to be adjusted. Parish Council members have discussed this reality and will be keeping their eyes and ears open to discover how best to address the needs of our parish family without ignoring the "new situation." The Northwest Deanery will also be seeking ways for the local parishes to cooperate in light of the problem of fewer priests.

What can you do? First, reflect on what priests have done for you in the past. Try to discover what they have done that you are able to do with the grace given to you by your Baptism. Second, pray for priests and for vocations to priesthood and religious life. Invite your children and grandchildren to listen to God's call to ministry and encourage them to respond. Priests come from families that live the Faith and support their members in this way.

I thank you for the loving support you have shown me and all the priests who have served at St. Timothy Church through the years. Special thanks go out to the Parish Council and to all our children in St. Timothy School and the Religious Education Program for their part in observing "Priesthood Sunday" a couple of weeks ago. Thanks, too, to all who have been praying for the priests on retreat. Let us continue to pray for one another.
