### A Word from Your Pastor

The Lenten Season is always a time of special grace and mercy. I have been on a circuit of hearing Confessions of both adults and children for weeks. This past week, we had our Parish celebration of the Lenten Penance Service. I am truly amazed at the power of this Sacrament to bring the truth of the Gospel home to hearts open to receive it. Many who come to the Sacrament after years away find it so consoling. It lifts burdens that are so heavy. With a few simple words, the Lord operates through the instrumentality of the priest we approach for absolution in the same healing ministry that is evident in the Gospels. It is Jesus Who says, "I absolve you from your sins." These words are effective. They cut right through to the heart of things. They free us from the weight of our own guilt and offer us room to renew our commitment to living in accord with what Jesus has taught us.

If you have not had the opportunity to receive the Sacrament, there is still time. It is offered every Saturday at 4:00 p.m. by the priest who will celebrate the 5:00 p.m. Vigil Mass. Any priest is happy to arrange time for the Sacrament if it is requested. Is the Lord calling you to draw near to Him and to purify your heart through His healing touch?

A very special experience of Mercy is being offered at St. Timothy for the first time this year on Divine Mercy Sunday, the Sunday after Easter. Through observance of this day as a Feast of Mercy, a special indulgence is granted to all who participate in the devotion. Plan to bring your Lenten practices to a wonderful completion through the Holy Hour and praying of the Divine Mercy Chaplet on that day from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. Preparation for reception of the special grace includes Sacramental Confession within a couple of weeks of that day.

I offer special thanks to the women of the Parish for sharing with me their annual breakfast last weekend. This year's theme, "All the Families of God," was a unifying idea. A survey concerning the renewal of the St. Timothy Women's Club was given. This same survey is available in the vestibule. All women of the parish are invited to let your voice be heard.
