## A WORD FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

**Happy Pentecost!** On this day, we celebrate the birth of the Catholic Church. Everything else that happened was a preparation for this event: the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on human beings who would carry forward the gift of redemption won by the Suffering, Death and Resurrection of Jesus. As the Spirit came upon the Apostles and those gathered with them in the upper room, including Mary, the Mother of Jesus, they became radically capable of the public witness called for by the Gospel.

Now it is our turn. We are called to be witnesses to the truth of the Gospel in word and action. Our world is in need of what only Jesus Christ can give. Our lives are meant to be a proclamation of salvation. This is not simply one part of our lives. It is the very purpose for which we were created. We have been plunged into the very reality of the Life of Jesus, sharing in His Death and Resurrection, through Baptism, made capable of bearing His Spirit through His Ascension and the Sacrament of Confirmation. Have you come to realize this truth? How do you respond to the Presence and action of the Holy Spirit in you?

As a Diocese, we are awaiting a sense of direction to be given by Bishop Campbell in response to the Parish Self-Study. However, one theme is already clearly in the forefront: evangelization. Catholics have a responsibility to share their Faith and to invite others to come to know Jesus Christ. This is written into our very being through the Gift of the Holy Spirit and the Sacrament of Confirmation. In order to accomplish this purpose, our sights must be focused in two directions: interiorly, toward our own knowledge and practice of our Faith, and outwardly, toward those we encounter in our daily lives. What do you need to know in order to be an evangelizer? Who do you know who is open to a proclamation of the Truth of the Gospel? Ask the Holy Spirit for Wisdom and for the grace of discernment. Then go out to all the world and tell the Good News.

**Prayer to the Holy Spirit**

*Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your love.*

*V. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created.*

*R. And You shall renew the face of the earth.*

Let us pray. *O God, Who did instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant us in the same Spirit to be truly wise and ever to rejoice in His consolation. Through Christ our Lord.*
