A Word from Your Pastor

Dear Parishioners:

Congratulations and Thanks to all who participated in our Festival on the Green!

It is always amazing to see how many folks come together to put on an event such as this. When you think of it, such a gathering of folks from all around is a tribute to the life of the whole community. Those who came before planted the seeds and watered the garden. We experience the fruit of their labors and now offer our own contribution. The children who participate today will be the leaders of tomorrow, and so on.

As it is with the *Festival on the Green*, so it also needs to be with our Catholic Faith. Our children need to learn from us the ways of Faith so that they will have this resource for the rest of their lives. Now is the time to consider how we will pass on this precious heritage to the next generation. As we begin our second year together, I want to enter in earnest into the effort to build up our community as a Family of Faith who know how to share the gift God has given us with others who seek Him.

Two fields are "ripe" for harvest. First, there are many among our families who have strayed away from the Faith. Some have perhaps gone to other communities through spouses or through an experience of something they thought we lacked. Others have been hurt by someone in our Church. Still others have simply stopped practicing. We need to discern the situations of these brothers and sisters and invite them to come home.

Now is the time to invite them to learn about the Catholic Faith and to discover whether God may be calling them to be one with us at the altar.
