We are almost into the 2009-2010 school year and we are anxiously awaiting its arrival. I am writing to inform you of some new and exciting things that you and your children will witness at St. Timothy School this year.

First of all, we will have two new teachers in our building. Mrs. Ann Polanco will be teaching Spanish this year. She taught at St. Tim for the 2007-2008 school year and is excited to be back in the building. We also welcome Ms. Ashley Mayer, who is a 2009 graduate of the University of Dayton. Ms. Mayer will be teaching 6th-7th grade Language Arts and 7th-8th grade Math. When you get a chance, please make sure to meet and greet our two fine staff additions.

Second, we have changed our middle school homerooms this year. In the past, we have had three homerooms, one each for sixth, seventh, and eighth grade. We will now have five middle school homerooms (families) and each homeroom will consist of a mixture of students from the three grades. We will meet the students first thing Monday in the gym and inform them of the changes and what homeroom they will be in.

We are extremely excited to announce that we have some new technology in the building. We have purchased five brand-new Smartboards for the school. Two Smartboards will be placed in middle school rooms, two will be placed in the downstairs wing, and one will be in the library. We also were able to purchase fifteen new computers to be placed in our Technology Lab. We are extremely excited to provide this new technology to our students.

This year, we are looking at applying for grants to assist our school. Grants are usually free to apply for and can provide alternative funds to our school. If you are aware of any grants that we can apply for, please contact me so I can provide this information to our Grant Writing Committee. Finally, we are pleased to announce that on Wednesday, August 26th, Dr. Todd Kays and Psychologist Maria Bucci will present a seminar in the gym, "Managing the Stress of Raising a Teenager." This seminar will run from 7:00-9:00 p.m. and it will take place immediately after the Middle School Curriculum Night, which is scheduled for 5:45-7:00 p.m. We encourage everyone to attend this worthwhile event.
