At 2:30 p.m., we are planning a Cornerstone Blessing ceremony for our new South Addition, as well as opening the original time capsule placed in the cornerstone of our former convent when the school was built in 1954.

The expansion includes Dominican Hall – a Multi-purpose Room to be used for class liturgies, retreats, parent meetings and alumni reunions – a full-size gym, gym lobby entrance, Eagle Store, wrestling room, athletic offices, training room, advancement/alumni offices, hall of champions, men’s and women’s rest rooms, kitchenette, instrumental and vocal music rooms, guidance and career center, renovation of locker rooms.

Phase I (North Addition) of the expansion opened May 2006. It includes a three-story area housing nine classrooms for art, science and technology.

**Notes on the Mass**

The readings taken from Sacred Scripture, together with the chants between them, constitute a principal part of the liturgy of the Word, and the homily, the profession of faith and the general prayer (prayer of the faithful) develop and conclude it. For in the readings, which the homily explains, God speaks to His people and makes known the mystery of redemption and salvation, and offers spiritual nourishment; and through His word Christ Himself is present in the midst of the faithful.
