### Notes on the Mass

Why is the Mass the same sacrifice as the sacrifice of the Cross?

The Mass is the sacrifice of the whole Christ, the Mystical Body united with its Head. Christ offers us up with Himself, including all our prayers, works and sufferings of every day. He offers these together with His own as our gift to tell the Father we love Him. In the Mass, the Father gives us the Flesh of His Son to eat as a sign that He is pleased and will one day raise our bodies from the dead to be with Him forever as accepted victims of sacrifice. – *The Baltimore Catechism*

The Mass is the same sacrifice as the sacrifice of the cross because in the Mass the victim is the same and the principal priest is the same, Jesus Christ. The manner in which the sacrifice is offered is different. On the cross, Christ physically shed His blood and was physically slain, while in the Mass there is no physical shedding of blood nor physical death because Christ can die no more; on the cross, Christ gained merit and satisfied for us, while in the Mass He applies to us the merits and satisfactions of His death on the cross.
