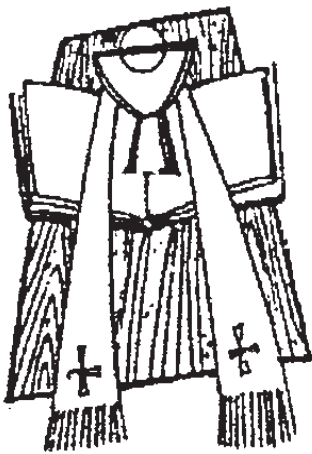

Thanks also to the St. Timothy Council of the Knights of Columbus for their financial support for the reception.

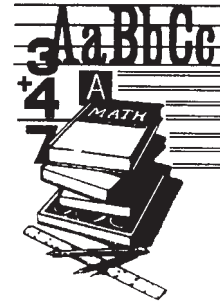

Marian Prayers for the Month of May:

The Regina Caeli

This is one of four Marian antiphons, with following versicles and prayers, traditionally said or sung after Night Prayer, immediately before going to sleep. It is said throughout Eastertide. (That is, the Liturgical Easter Season, from Easter Day through Pentecost, the seventh Sunday after Easter.) The *Regina Caeli* is also traditionally said in place of the *Angelus* during Eastertide.

V. Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia.

R. For He whom you merited to bear, alleluia.

V. Has risen, as he said, alleluia.

R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.

V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.

R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray. *O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.*
