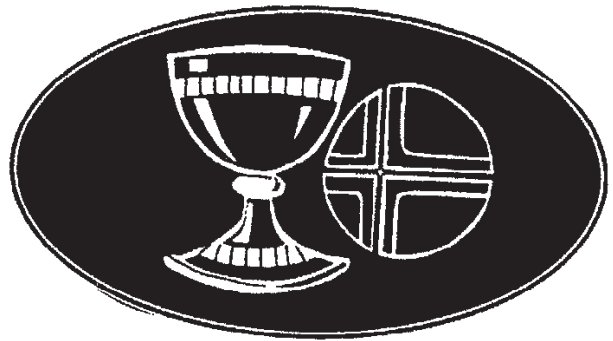

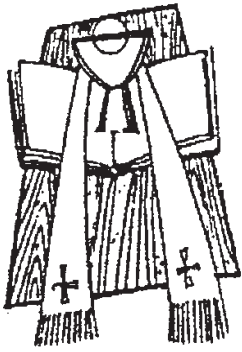

## A Word from Your Pastor

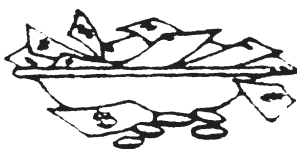
Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, the "Birthday of the Church." With this feast, the Easter Season comes to its dramatic conclusion with the account of the Church's reception of the Gift of the Holy Spirit. This Gift is the fulfillment of God's Promise, a sharing of the very Life of God in and among us. 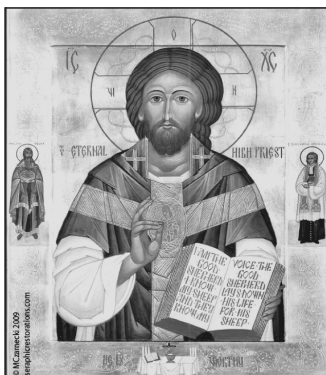
*Grant me the gift of knowledge, so that I may know the things of God and, enlightened by Your holy teaching, may walk, without deviation, in the path of eternal salvation.*
