

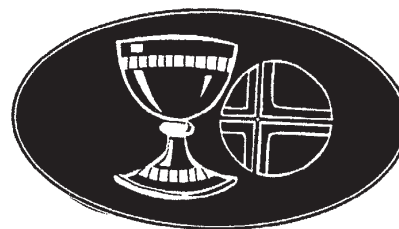

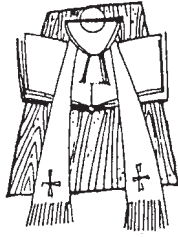

in saecula saeculorum. Amen.*

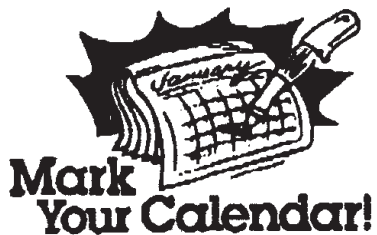
*Soul of Christ, sanctify me.

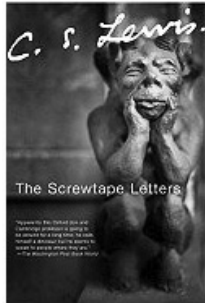

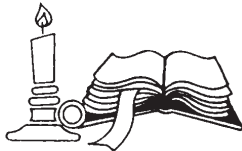
